We have now had our first full year with our Director of Golf Jason and his Pro Shop team successfully running our events. Whilst the committee doesn't take the money, do the entries, process daily results etc we continue to have autonomy over our events and how they are run. Next year we will also trial at least one optional drawn event so we can mix a bit more and get to know each other a little better.
