### **CAPTAIN'S REPORT**

A challenging year with a good deal of inclement weather, a new Women's Captain and updates and changes to the Shelly Beach golf course. All for the betterment of the game but requiring some short-term adjustments on the part of our players.

Thank you to Andrew Benning and his team who have done an outstanding job of presenting the course in the best possible way every week.

Our membership currently sits at 350 and continues to grow. It is made up of several categories, the main being:

- Full playing 203
- Tyro (all categories) 50
- Women's 5 Day members 12
- Junior 5

Our Wednesday mid-week competition continues to be well patronised with between 90-110 players on a regular basis. Of particular interest is the patronage of stroke events with 4 of the 6 medal rounds having over 100 players. Our continued thanks go to Jason and his team for running the events and his willingness to consult with the Women's Match Committee through our regular monthly meeting. We appreciate the effort that goes into supporting and improving golf for women players. Our committee has autonomy over the events that we offer and how they are run. Jason, the Board and GM Geoff are very accommodating and supportive of the events that are held.

Our club holds a variety of events including daily competitions, Pennants in all its varieties, Pro Ams and Top Gal that we can participate in and enjoy. Women can take the field on every day but Thursday as this is a dedicated men's competition day. This diverse range of events offers something for everyone.

Each of our progressives this year has had a different format. Our Opening Day (Team Ambrose) CCWGA charity Day (Top 9 plus division winners on the nominated Day), Oncology Day is a Waltz format, Invitation Day (1 score on par 3 holes, 2 scores on par 4 holes and 3 scores to count on par 5 holes). Gala Day is always enjoyed with our 3 clubs and a putter format with best 2 scores to count.

Our Facebook Group continues to be an effective way to communicate with the women members and all women golfers are encouraged to use this valuable source of information to keep abreast of what is happening each week. There is an email group as well. The Facebook page is encouraged over the email group as it means less work for the Women's Captain in keeping you all informed and up to date! You do not have to actively participate in Facebook to join the Shelley Beach Women's Golf page, but you do need to be a member of the Shelly Beach Women's golf community.

The Tyros program continues to do well and is very popular with those who wish to learn the basics of golf. Many of these women go on to become full playing members and are most welcome in all our events.

Stage 1 of the Clubhouse and course changes are ready to be opened with new forward tee boxes constructed on some holes in play. Our Captain Pete Sliwinski has updated our committee and women members who were interested on future changes to be implemented.

We have a very collegial, collaborative and hardworking committee and club members who are generous with their time to help when needed.

Lastly, thank you to all the women who join in regularly in the variety of competitions that are part of Shelly golfing life. I appreciate all the thoughts that experienced golfers have shared with me and hope I will continue to be able to answer or find an answer for you as required. It's been a huge learning curve for me, but at the same time my pleasure to give back and make great connections.
